DID YOU KNOW... that former Cincinnati Bengal and NFL Hall of Fame offensive lineman Anthony Munoz was a Christian athlete and longtime friend of the Knights of Columbus? He has worked for many years with the Knight's sports division and on Special Olympics projects. Last year, just one week before the Super Bowl, Munoz joined another member of the NFL Hall of Fame, Dave Casper, to distribute coats to students at a Catholic grammar school in San Francisco. The Anthony Munoz Foundation, in conjunction with the Knights of Columbus, have also collaborated to sponsor youth camps for the NFL Play 60 campaign whose goal it is to get kids physically active for at least 60 minutes a day. Events such as these are small examples of the charitable work carried out by both the Munoz Foundation and the Knights of Columbus to try and help youth with their mental, physical, and spiritual health. Munoz was presented with a Lifetime Achievement Award by Univision Sports Network on December 18, 2016 for his charitable work with youth.
